- 1 Title**
This Act is the Employment Relations Amendment Act (No 2) **2007**.

- 2 Commencement**
This Act comes into force on the day after the date on which it receives the Royal assent. 5

- 10 Amendments to Employment Relations Act 2000**
This subpart amends the Employment Relations Act 2000.

- 11 Age of retirement** 10
Section 205 is amended by omitting “68” and substituting “70”.

- 12 Appointment of temporary Judges**
(1) Section 207(2) is amended by omitting “68” and substituting “70”. 15

- (2) Section 207(4) is amended by omitting “68” and substituting “70”.
