A BILL INTITULED

AN ACT to amend "The Education Reserves Act, 1877." Title.

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. The Short Title of this Act is "The Education Reserves Act, 1905"; and it shall form part of and be read together with "The Education Reserves Act, 1877." Short Title.

2. The expenses of management and administration of reserves mentioned in section twenty-one of "The Education Reserves Act, 1877," shall be deemed to include the whole or any part of the cost of surveying, constructing, or improving any road, bridge, ferry, or ford necessary, in the opinion of the School Commissioners, to the leasing or subdivision of any land now or hereafter vested in them, and the construction or improvement of which has been approved by the Minister, and the School Commissioners are hereby empowered to pay or contract to pay such cost in any manner they think fit. sioners may
construct
subdivisional roads
on reserves.
