A BILL INTITULED

An Act to amend the Electrical Supply Authorities Title. Association Act 1930.

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New 5 Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1. This Act may be cited as the Electrical Supply Short Title. Authorities Association Amendment Act 1955, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Electrical See Reprint of 10 Supply Authorities Association Act 1930 (hereinafter referred to as the principal Act).

2. Section ten of the principal Act is hereby amended Election of by repealing subsection two, as set out in subsection two of section eleven of the Statutes Amendment Act 1951, Executive 15 and substituting the following subsection:

"(2) The President and the other elected members of the Executive Committee shall be elected annually at the annual meeting of the Association and shall come into office at the conclusion of the annual meeting at which 20 they are elected. A nomination paper in respect of every
