#### A BILL INTITULED

# An Act to repeal the Economic Stabilisation Act 1948 and to make provision incidental thereto

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in 5 Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1. Short Title—This Act may be cited as the Economic Stabilisation Act Repeal Act 1986.
- 2. **Repeals**—The following enactments are hereby repealed, 10 namely:
  - (a) The Economic Stabilisation Act 1948:
  - (b) The Economic Stabilisation Amendment Act 1968:
  - (c) The Economic Stabilisation Amendment Act 1982:
  - (d) Part I of the Finance Act 1983.
- 15 **3. Consequential amendments and repeals**—(1) The enactment specified in the **First** Schedule to this Act is hereby consequentially amended in the manner indicated in that Schedule.
- (2) The enactments specified in the Second Schedule to this 20 Act are hereby consequentially repealed.
