A BILL INTITULED

AN ACT to regulate the Exercise of the Educational Franchise. Title.
BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in
Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. The Short Title of this Act is "The Educational Vote Act, Short Title.
1887."

2. Notwithstanding anything contained in "The Education Act, Number of votes.
1877," at any election of a School Committee or of members of a
School Committee held in accordance with the provisions of the said
Act or of "The Education Act 1877 Amendment Act, 1885," every
householder may exercise as many votes as there are persons required
to be elected, or any less number of votes; but no householder shall
be entitled to record more than one vote for any one candidate.
