A BILL INTITULED

AN ACT to amend "The Fencing Act, 1881."

Title.

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

5 1. The Short Title of this Act is "The Fencing Act 1881 Amendment Act, 1892." Short Title.

2. This Act shall be deemed to be and shall be read and construed as part of "The Fencing Act, 1881." Interpretation.

10 3. Any person becoming the occupier of any land separated from any adjoining land by a dividing-fence made by the occupier of such adjoining land is, in respect of such dividing-fence, subject to the same liabilities as such first-named occupier is subject to when he relinquishes possession. Fresh occupiers of land liable for dividing-fences.
