AN ACT to amend the Factories Act, 1908.

Title.

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the Factories Act Amendment Act, 1914, and shall form part of and be read together with the Factories Act, 1908 (hereinafter referred to as the principal Act).

Short Title.

2. Section twenty of the principal Act is hereby repealed.
