A BILL INTITULED

AN ACT to amend the Fisheries Act, 1908.

Title.

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the Fisheries Amendment Act, 1908, and shall form part of and be read with the Fisheries Act, 1908 (hereinafter referred to as the principal Act).

Short Title.

2. (1.) The Governor may from time to time make regulations under section eighty-three of the principal Act for the issue to Maoris of licenses to fish for trout and perch at such rate not exceeding five shillings for the whole season as he may prescribe.

Special licenses to Maoris to fish for trout or perch.

(2.) If the holder of any such license is convicted of any breach of the principal Act, or of any regulation made thereunder, his license may be cancelled by the convicting Court, and he shall not be entitled to a fresh license during the remainder of the season.
