FINANCE BILL

EXPLANATORY NOTE

Clause 1 relates to the Short Title and commencement. Except for clause 4, which is deemed to have come into force on 28 August 1980, the Bill comes into force on receiving the Governor-General's assent.

Clause 2 re-enacts, with an amendment, section 35 of the Finance Act 1950, which authorises local authorities that are members of the South Island Local Bodies Association (Incorporated) to pay subscriptions to the Association and expend money on attending meetings. At present subscriptions must not exceed amounts to be prescribed by Order in Council. This limitation is now removed, and local authorities may lawfully pay any subscription the Association fixes.

Subclause (2) validates the unlawful payment to the Association since 30 September 1976 by various local bodies of subscriptions that exceeded the limits imposed by statute. Payments were also made at unlawfully high rates before 30 September 1976, but those payments were validated by section 4 (5) of the Finance Act 1976.

Clause 3 authorises the Minister of Finance to acquire shares in Air New Zealand Limited. The clause also validates the acquisition of 8,000,000 \$2 shares, and the payment of \$16,000,000 for them, on 22 July 1980.

Clause 4 authorises the Minister of Finance to acquire shares in Alliance Textiles Limited. It is deemed to have come into force on 28 August 1980.

Clause 5 repeals the Services Export Development Grants Act 1973, and provides for the disposal of applications for grants made before 1 April 1980.

Clause 6 relates to the Freshwater Fisheries Regulations 1951, Amendment No. 16. Although these regulations did not come into force until 12 June 1980, acclimatisation societies have since 1 October 1978 been issuing licences as if a number of amendments contained in the regulations had come into force on that date. The clause validates all the actions involved.

Clause 7 relates to regulation 2 of the Music Teachers Registration Regulations 1966, Amendment No. 3. Although this regulation (which increases from \$10 to \$17 the annual fee payable by registered music teachers) did not come into force until 17 July 1980, the Music Teachers Registration Board has collected that fee at the higher rate since 1 January 1980. The clause validates the Board's actions in doing so.

Clause 8 repeals 292 Appropriation and Imprest Supply Acts. These are all annual Acts that are now spent.

Clause 9 repeals a number of spent enactments, including 17 entire Acts. Subclauses (2) and (3) are savings provisions preserving the consequences of certain of the provisions repealed.

A BILL INTITULED

An Act to make provision with respect to public finances and other matters

- BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand 5 in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:
 - 1. Short Title and commencement—(1) This Act may be cited as the Finance Act 1980.
- (2) Subject to section 4 (4) of this Act, this Act shall come 10 into force on the day on which it receives the Governor-General's assent.

2. Payments related to South Island Local Bodies Associa-15 tion—(1) It shall be lawful for any local authority that is a member of the South Island Local Bodies Association (Incorporated) to pay from its general revenues-

- (a) Any subscription payable by it under the rules of that Association: (b) The reasonable travelling expenses of its representatives incurred in attending meetings of that Association or of the Executive Committee of that Association. (2) The actions of any such local authority in paying to the said Association before the commencement of this Act any annual subscription that was unlawful by virtue of the fact that it exceeded the appropriate amount prescribed by 10 section 35 (4) of the Finance Act 1950 are hereby validated and deemed to have been lawful. (3) The following enactments are hereby consequentially repealed: 15 (a) Section 35 of the Finance Act 1950: (b) Section 4 of the Finance Act 1976. 3. Air New Zealand Limited—(1) In this section, "the Company" means Air New Zealand Limited, the duly incorporated company of that name having its registered office in Auckland. 20 (2) The Minister of Finance may from time to time,— (a) On behalf of Her Majesty the Queen, subscribe for or
 - otherwise acquire shares in the Company:
 (b) From the Consolidated Account or the Loans Account, out of money appropriated by Parliament for the 25 purpose, pay for any such shares so acquired:

(c) On behalf of Her Majesty the Queen, exercise all or any of Her Majesty's rights and powers as the holder of any shares in the Company.

(3) The actions of the Minister of Finance on the 22nd day 30 of July 1980, on behalf of Her Majesty the Queen, in—

(a) Subscribing for 8 000 000 \$2 shares in the Company;

- (b) Paying \$16,000,000 to the Company for those shares—are hereby validated and deemed to have been lawful.
- **4.** Alliance Textiles Limited—(1) In this section, "the Company" means Alliance Textiles Limited, the duly incorporated company of that name having its registered office in Dunedin.
- (2) Subject to subsection (3) of this section, the Minister 40 of Finance may from time to time,—
 - (a) On behalf of Her Majesty the Queen, subscribe for or otherwise acquire shares in the Company:

(b) Advance money to the Company by way of a debenture that is partly convertible into shares in the Company:

(c) From the Consolidated Account or the Leans Account, out of money appropriated by Parliament for the purpose, pay for any such shares so acquired, and so advance any money:

(d) On behalf of Her Majesty the Queen, exercise all or any of Her Majesty's rights and powers under any such debenture or as the holder of any shares in the Company.

(3) The total of all amounts paid, payable, or advanced under subsection (2) of this section shall not exceed \$1,000,000.

15 (4) This section shall be deemed to have come into force on the 28th day of August 1980.

25 (2) The Services Export Grants Advisory Committee established by section 4 of the Act is hereby abolished.

(3) Notwithstanding subsection (1) of this section, the Minister of Overseas Trade shall have and may exercise, in respect of all applications for grants under the Act made before the 1st day of April 1980 and not disposed of before the commencement of this Act, the powers that he had immediately before the commencement of this Act.

35 (4) For the purposes of subsection (3) of this section, the Secretary of Trade and Industry shall have the functions that the Services Export Grants Advisory Committee had under section 10 of the Act immediately before the commencement of this Act.

(5) The repeal of the Services Export Grants Amendment Act 1976 by subsection (1) of this section shall not affect the validity of any act or thing validated by section 3 (2) of that Act.

(6) Without limiting the generality of the Acts Interpretation Act 1924, it is hereby expressly declared that every power and act that may be necessary—

- (a) To complete, carry out, or compel, any payment of money duly authorised by the Minister under the Act; or
- (b) To complete, carry out, or compel the performance of, any contract, agreement, or deed, made, entered into, or commenced, under the Act; or
- (c) To comply, or compel compliance, with any term or condition attaching to the making of any payment under the Act—

may be exercised and performed as if this section had not 10 been passed.

- 6. Validating unlawful charges for and issue of fishing licences—Regulations 2 (4), 4, 5, 6, 7, 9, and 10 of, and the First, Second, and Third Schedules to, the Freshwater Fisheries Regulations 1951, Amendment No. 16* are hereby 15 deemed to have come into force on the 1st day of October 1978.
- 7. Music Teachers Registration Board: Validating unlawful collection of fees—Regulation 2 of the Music Teachers Registration Regulations 1966, Amendment No. 3† is hereby 20 deemed to have come into force on the 1st day of January 1980.
- 8. Repeal of spent Appropriation and Imprest Supply Acts—The Acts specified in the First Schedule to this Act are hereby repealed.
- 9. Repeals and savings—(1) The enactments specified in the Second Schedule to this Act are hereby repealed.
- (2) The repeal of section 5 of the Finance Act (No. 2) 1964 by subsection (1) of this section shall not affect the eligibility of any person to receive any superannuation payments or the rate at which any such payments are made.
- (3) The repeal of the Finance Act 1979 by subsection (1) of this section shall not affect the validity of any action vali-
