2. Penalty for selling or taking undersized

A BILL INTITULED

An Act to amend "The Fisheries Conservation Act, 1884."

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. The Short Title of this Act is "The Fisheries Conservation Short Title. Act 1884 Amendment Act, 1891." It shall be read and construed with "The Fisheries Conservation Act, 1884" (herein referred to as "the said Act").

2. Any person who commits any of the following offences is liable Penalty for selling 10 to a penalty of not less than *one* pound or more than *fifty* pounds:—

(1.) Who buys, sells, exposes for sale, or has in his possession any fish of the species known as flounder of a size less than eleven inches in length:

(2.) Who takes within any fishery affected by regulations made under the said Act any fish of the species known as flounder of a size less than eleven inches in length, and omits to immediately return the said fish to the waters of the fishery whence it was taken.

or taking undersize flounders.
