This Public Bill originated in the House of Representatives, and, having this day passed as now printed, is transmitted to the LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL for its concurrence.

FOREIGN INSURANCE COMPANIES DEPOSITS ACT AMENDMENT.

Title. 1. Short Title. 2. Fee for Public Trustee's certificate.

A BILL INTITULED

An Act to amend the Law relating to Foreign Insurance Companies. Title. BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as fol-5 lows :--

1. The Short Title of this Act is "The Foreign Insurance short Title. Companies Deposits Act Amendment Act, 1900," and it shall form part of and be read together with "The Foreign Insurance Companies Deposits Act, 1894."

2. For every certificate issued under section four of "The Fee for Public 10 Foreign Insurance Companies Deposits Act, 1894," there shall be paid to the Public Trustee by the foreign company receiving the certificate such fee, not exceeding three guineas, as the Governor from time to time prescribes.
