FAMILY PROTECTION AMENDMENT.

Title.	ANALYSIS.
1. Short Title.	2. Section 33 of Family Protection Act amended.

A BILL INTITULED

AN ACT to amend the Family Protection Act, 1908.

Title.

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the Family Protection Amendment Act, 1921, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Family Protection Act, 1908.

Short Title.

2. Subsection nine of section thirty-three of the Family Protection Act, 1908, is hereby amended as follows:—

Section 33 of Family Protection Act amended.

(a.) By omitting from the first proviso the words "of twelve months"; and by adding to that proviso the words "but in all such cases the application for extension shall be made before the final distribution of the estate, and no distribution of any part of the estate made prior to the application shall be disturbed by reason of the application or of an order made thereon."

(b.) By repealing the second proviso.
