A BILL INTITULED

AN ACT to amend "The Friendly Societies Act, 1882." Title.
 BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in
 Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as fol-
 lows:—

1. The Short Title of this Act is "The Friendly Societies Act Short Title.
 1882 Amendment Act, 1887."

2. In lieu of the words "fifty pounds," in subsection one of Sections 7 and 31 of
"Friendly Societies
Act, 1882," amended
 section seven and in section thirty-one of "The Friendly Societies
 Act, 1882," there shall henceforth be read "two hundred pounds,"
 and in lieu of the words "two hundred pounds," in such subsection
 one of section seven, and in such section thirty-one, there shall be
 read "three hundred pounds."
