1. Short Title and commencement	

A BILL INTITULED

**An Act to amend the Fair Trading Act 1986**

BE IT ENACTED by the Parliament of New Zealand as follows:

5 **1. Short Title and commencement**—(1) This Act may be cited as the Fair Trading Amendment Act (No. 2) 1999, and is part of the Fair Trading Act 1986 (“the principal Act”).

(2) This Act comes into force on the day after the date on which it receives the Royal assent.

10 **7B. Other orders**—(1) Section 43 (4) of the principal Act is amended by omitting the expression “\$3,000” wherever it occurs, and substituting in each case the expression “\$7,500”.

(2) Section 43 (4A) of the principal Act is amended—

15 (a) By omitting the expression “\$3,000”, and substituting the expression “\$7,500”; and

(b) By omitting the expression “\$5,000”, and substituting the expression “\$12,000”.
