A BILL INTITULED

AN ACT to amend the Gaming Act, 1908.

Title.

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the Gaming Amendment Act, 1921, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Gaming Act, 1908. Short Title.
2. Subsection two of section five of the Gaming Amendment Act, 1910, is hereby amended by omitting the words "two hundred and fifty," and substituting the words "two hundred and seventy-eight." Section 5 of Gaming Amendment Act, 1910, amended.
