A BILL INTITULED

AN ACT to amend the Gaming Act, 1908.

Title.

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the Gaming Amendment Act, 1930, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Gaming Act, 1908 (hereinafter referred to as the principal Act).

Short Title.

2. (1) Section twenty-eight of the principal Act is hereby repealed.
 10 (2) Section twenty-nine of the principal Act is hereby amended by adding thereto the words "unless such telegram is addressed to the secretary of the racing club under the control of which any race meeting is being held."

3. Section thirty of the principal Act is hereby amended by repealing subsections one, four, and six thereof.
