A BILL INTITULED

An Act to amend the Gaming Act 1908

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, 5 as follows:

- 1. Short Title—This Act may be cited as the Gaming Amendment Act 1964, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Gaming Act 1908* (hereinafter referred to as the principal Act).
- 2. Additional totalisator days—(1) Section 50 of the principal Act (as substituted by section 2 of the Gaming Amendment Act 1950 and amended by section 5 of the Gaming Amendment Act 1953) is hereby further amended by omitting from the proviso to subsection (2) the word "twenty-three", and substituting the word "forty-seven"
- 15 and substituting the word "forty-seven".

 (2) Section 5 of the Gaming Amendment Act 1953 is hereby repealed.
