AN ACT to amend "The Gaming and Lotteries Act, 1881." BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as 5 follows :---

1. The Short Title of this Act is "The Gaming and Lotteries Act Short Title. 1881 Amendment Act, 1887," and it shall be read together with "The Gaming and Lotteries Act, 1881" (hereinafter called "the said Act.")
