A BILL INTITULED

An Act to further amend "The Gaming and Lotteries Act, 1881." Title. WHEREAS it is expedient to further amend "The Gaming and Preamble.

Lotteries Act, 1881 " (hereinafter referred to as "the said Act").

BE IT THEREFORE ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:---

1. The Short Title of this Act is "The Gaming and Lotteries Short Title.

Act 1881 Further Amendment Act, 1885."

2. Notwithstanding anything contained in the said Act or Certain sweepstakes any amendment thereof, any sweepstakes or sweep drawn on any to be exempted from "The Gaming racecourse on the occasion of any race meeting, or within view of and Lotteries Act, any race, shooting, coursing, or other match, athletic or aquatic contest or game of skill, in which sweepstakes or sweep the share or 15 stake of each individual participating therein shall not exceed the sum of one pound, shall be exempted from the operation of the said Act or any amendment thereof.
