5 WHEREAS the land described in the First Schedule hereto is Praemble. vested in the Gore Athenaum (incorporated), and the lands described in the Second Schedule hereto were some time since set apart as a site for an Athenaum: And whereas, as a memorial of the coronation of His Majesty the King, the Mayor, Councillors, and Bur-10 gesses of the Borough of Gore are desirous of establishing a public library in the Borough of Gore, and with that object have agreed with the Trustees of the Gore Athenæum to purchase the property of the said Trustees and conduct the said Atheneum as a public library, and with such object are desirous of having the said reserves vested 15 in the said borough, and the said Trustees are desirous of transferring the other property of the said Athenæum to the said borough:

BE IT THEREFORE ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the

SCHEDULES.

FIRST SCHEDULE.

ALL that parcel of land, situated in the Town of Gore, containing by admeasurement 2 roods 4 perches, more or less, being section numbered VII., Block I., on the map of the said town.

SECOND SCHEDULE.
