 $B^{\rm E}$ IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows :—

1. The Short Title of this Act shall be "The Gold Duties Act Short 5 1872 Amendment Act, 1876."

2. On and after the first day of January, one thousand eight hundred and seventy-seven, in lieu of the duties authorized by the third section of "The Gold Duties Act, 1872," to be levied and collected, a duty of one shilling per ounce shall be levied and collected, 10 and on and after the first day of January, one thousand eight hundred and seventy-eight, a duty of threepence per ounce shall be levied and collected.
