A BILL INTITULED

AN ACT to provide for the Abolition of the Export Duty on Gold. Title.

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows :— Preamble.

1. The Short Title of this Act shall be "The Gold Duty Abolition Act, 1875." Short Title.

2. At the expiration of one month after the close of the present Session of the General Assembly, the whole of the several Acts and Ordinances or parts of Acts or Ordinances mentioned and referred to in the Schedule hereto shall be deemed and taken to be repealed, and thereafter the duty heretofore levied collected and paid at the Customs upon gold previous to exportation from New Zealand shall wholly cease and determine. Gold Duties Acts and Ordinances repealed, and gold duty abolished.

"THE Gold Duties Act, 1870." "The Gold Duties Act, 1872." All other Acts or parts of Acts of the General Assembly providing for the payment, collection, or expenditure of the export duty on gold.
