### A BILL INTITULED

AN ACT to provide for the Abolition of the Export Title.  
Duty on Gold.

**B**E IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in  
Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as  
follows:—

1. The Short Title of this Act shall be “The Gold Duty Abolition Short Title.  
5 Act, 1878.”

2. At the expiration of one month after the close of the present Gold Duties Acts and  
Ordinances repealed,  
and gold duty abol-  
ished.  
10 in the Schedule hereto shall be deemed and taken to be repealed,  
and thereafter the duty heretofore levied, collected, and paid at the  
Customs upon gold previous to exportation from New Zealand shall  
wholly cease and determine.

### SCHEDULE.

Schedule.

“The Gold Duties Act, 1870.” “The Gold Duties Act, 1872.” All other Acts or  
parts of Acts of the General Assembly providing for the payment, collection, or  
expenditure of the export duty on gold. All Acts or Ordinances, or parts of Acts or  
Ordinances, of the Superintendent and Provincial Council of any province providing for  
the payment, collection, or expenditure of the export duty on gold.
