A BILL INTITULED

AN ACT to further amend "The Gisborne Harbour Act, 1884," and the Several Amendments thereof. Title.

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. The Short Title of this Act is "The Gisborne Harbour Board Empowering Act, 1896." Short Title.

2. This Act shall be deemed to be a special Act within the meaning of "The Harbours Act, 1878," which Act is hereby incorporated in this Act. Deemed to be a special Act.

3. In this Act, the expression—  
"The Board" means the Gisborne Harbour Board: Interpretation.

"The said Acts" means "The Gisborne Harbour Act, 1884," and includes the several amendments thereof respectively.

4. Notwithstanding anything in the said Acts or in any of them contained to the contrary, it shall be lawful for the Public Trustee, and he is hereby authorised and directed, to pay to the Board out of the unexpended balance of fifty-nine thousand one hundred and sixty-six pounds of loan-money, with the accrued interest thereon, now vested in him under the provisions of the said Acts, the sum of fifteen thousand pounds. Public Trustee to pay to the Board £15,000.

5. It shall be lawful, and the Board is hereby authorised and empowered, to expend the sum of ten thousand pounds, part of the said sum of fifteen thousand pounds, in repairing and keeping in proper repair the harbour-works already constructed by the Board under the provisions of the said Acts. Authorising Board to expend £10,000.

6. It shall be lawful, and the Board is hereby further empowered and authorised, to expend the balance of the said sum of fifteen thousand pounds—namely, the sum of five thousand pounds—in repairing and extending towards the sea the western groin of the said works heretofore duly authorised to be constructed. Authorising expenditure of £5,000 by the Board.

7. The said sum of fifteen thousand pounds shall be paid by the Public Trustee to the Board in such amounts as the Board may from time to time require the same. £15,000 to be paid by Public Trustee in such amounts as required.
