BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. The Short Title of this Act is "The Gisborne High School Short Title.

principal Act"), is to be read herewith.

3. The rents, profits, and annual income from the lands de-10 scribed in the First Schedule to the principal Act, including all rents, profits, and annual income which have already accrued under the provisions of the said principal Act, or of any other Act or regulation for the establishment or maintenance of secondary education in the County of Cook, shall be paid by the Commissioners appointed 15 under "The Education Reserves Act, 1877," to the Board, and shall

be applied by the Board to the purposes set out in section nineteen of the principal Act and in this Act.

4. The Board, for a period not exceeding seven years, may pay Board may grant out of its funds any sum not being more than one hundred and fifty income in all of district school for 20 pounds per annum to defray the salary of an assistant master teaching in the public school at Gisborne: Provided that such school is constituted and maintained as a district high school under the provisions of "The Education Act, 1877."

5. The Board may invest its annual income or other moneys in Board may invest 25 manner provided in the twentieth section of the principal Act.

6. The Board may purchase, for cash or on deferred payments, Board may purchase a site for a school or schools, including suitable playgrounds, here-school-site and play-ground. after to be established under the principal Act and this Act.
