GISBORNE HIGH SCHOOL AMENDMENT.

[LOCAL BILL.]

ANALYSIS.

Title.

1. Short Title.

The principal Act. Vesting Allotment No. 184, Town of Gisborne, as a site for a high school.

A BILL INTITULED

An Act to provide, inter alia, for the Acquirement of a Site for Title. School Buildings for the Gisborne High School.

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand 5 in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:-

1. This Act may be cited as the Gisborne High School short Title. Amendment Act, 1909.

2. The Gisborne High School Act, 1885, is herein referred to The principal Act.

3. Whereas the lands described in the First Schedule hereto vesting Allotment are an education reserve in the Town of Gisborne reserved for primary Gisborne, as a site education: And whereas the said lands are not required for primary- for a high school. school buildings: And whereas the Gisborne High School Board 15 has expended large sums of money for the erection of buildings at

Gisborne for secondary education upon the premises occupied by the Education Board of the Education District of Hawke's Bay for primary education, and it is desirable to erect separate buildings for the Gisborne High School apart from the primary school:

The reservation of the said lands as an endowment for primary education is hereby cancelled, and the said lands are hereby vested in the Gisborne High School Board, and shall be applied by the said Gisborne High School Board for school buildings and premises, school boardinghouses, masters' residences, or for the purposes set 25 out in section nineteen of the principal Act:

No. 16-1.

Provided that nothing herein contained shall affect, prejudice, or impair any contract hereinbefore entered into concerning or touching the said lands, but any such contract shall continue in full force and effect.

Vesting certain reserves, the rents and profits of which now belong to the Gisborne High School Board, for high-school purposes.

4. The lands described in the Second Schedule hereto, now 5 vested in the School Commissioners of the Provincial District of Auckland, but the rents, profits, and income of which are payable to the Gisborne High School Board in terms of the principal Act, are hereby divested from the said School Commissioners and vested in the Gisborne High School Board, to be applied by the said Board 10 for the purposes set out in section nineteen of the principal Act:

Provided that nothing herein contained shall affect, prejudice, or impair any contract hereinbefore entered into by the School Commissioners with any person or persons, but any such contract shall for

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all purposes continue in full force and effect.

5. The Governor may by Gazette notice set apart as an endowment for primary education the lands described in the Third Schedule hereto in exchange for the lands described in the First Schedule, and may grant the same to the School Commissioners of Auckland for the objects and purposes and upon the same trusts for and upon 20 which the lands described in the said First Schedule were held.

6. Section twenty-four of the principal Act is hereby

repealed.

7. To give effect to and carry out the provisions of this Act the District Land Registrar for the Land Registration District of Poverty 25 Bay is hereby authorised to cancel, call in, or rectify any certificates of title heretofore issued for any of the lands described in the First and Second Schedules hereto, and to issue new certificates of title for the same in the name of the said Gisborne High School Board; and the production of a request under the common seal of the said 30 Board, together with a copy of this Act, shall be alone a sufficient transmission for the completion of title in the Gisborne High School Board to the said lands.
