A BILL INTITULED

An Act authorizing certain Dealings with Part of the Greymouth Title. Native Reserve.

WHEREAS it was agreed some time since between the Greymouth
Borough Council (hereinafter called the Council) and the Greymouth
Trotting Club (Registered), (hereinafter called the club) that the
parcels of land mentioned and described in Parts I and II of the
First Schedule hereto (being parts of the Greymouth Native Reserve)
should be acquired by the Council and that the Council should upon
such acquisition, and for the consideration agreed upon between the
Council and the club, cause or procure the parcel of land mentioned
and described in Part II of the said First Schedule to be vested in
the club for an estate in fee-simple: And whereas the Council and
the Public Trustee agreed upon the amount of compensation which

the Public Trustee agreed upon the amount of compensation which would have been payable upon the acquisition of the said parcels of land, and the Council paid such amount to the Public Trustee, but the steps for acquiring the said parcels of land were never completed: And whereas the club has also paid to the Council the consideration agreed upon as aforesaid: And whereas it is desirable to vest the 20 said parcels of land in the parties entitled thereto, and to make other

20 said parcels of land in the parties entitled thereto, and to make other provisions in relation thereto and to certain other low-lying and waste lands in the Greymouth Native Reserve:

BE IT THEREFORE ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, 25 as follows:—

- 1. This Act may be cited as the Greymouth Native Reserve Short Title. Act, 1915.
- 2. (1.) The estate in fee-simple in the land comprised in Part I certain land vested of the *First* Schedule hereto is hereby declared to be vested in the in the Council. 30 Council.

- (2.) The estate in fee-simple in the land comprised in Part II of the *First* Schedule hereto is hereby declared to be vested in the club.
- (3.) The District Land Registrar, at Hokitika, is hereby authorized to issue certificates of title in respect of the lands mentioned in Parts I and II of the *First* Schedule hereto to the Council and the club respectively, and to cancel the certificate of title wherein such lands are at present included in so far as it relates to such lands.

3. (1.) The Public Trustee is hereby authorized to sell to the club the estate in fee-simple in the land described in the Second 10

Schedule hereto or any part of such land.

(2.) The price to be paid by the club shall be such as shall be agreed upon between the Public Trustee and the club or, in default of agreement, shall be fixed by two arbitrators (one to be appointed by the Public Trustee and the other by the club) or their umpire in 15 accordance with the provisions of the Arbitration Act, 1908.

(3.) Upon the delivery to the District Land Registrar, at Hokitika, of any memorandum of transfer executed by the Public Trustee under the provisions of this section the said Registrar shall issue to the club a certificate of title in respect of the land comprised in such memorandum of transfer, and shall cancel the certificate of title wherein such land is at present included in so far as it relates to such land.
