## A BILL INTITULED

AN ACT to empower the Education Board of the District of South Title. Canterbury to sell certain Reserves for School Purposes, and otherwise, and the Buildings and Improvements thereon, and to apply the Proceeds in making Better Provision for School Purposes at Geraldine.

WHEREAS it is expedient to grant power to the said Board for the Preamble. before-mentioned purposes :

BE IT THEREFORE ENACTED by the General Assembly of New 10 Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows :--

1. The Short Title of this Act is "The Geraldine Public School Short Title. Site Act, 1889."

- 2. It shall be lawful for the said Board, with the written consent Board to have power 15 of the Governor, when and so soon as it may deem expedient, to sell to sell and described in First Schedule and dispose of from time to time, either together or in lots, and either and the buildings by public auction or tender, or partly in one mode and partly in another, and subject to such conditions as it shall think fit, the several parcels of land described in the First and Second Schedules hereto, or
- 20 any part or parts thereof respectively, with the buildings and improvements thereon, and to execute transfers and assurances thereof to the respective purchasers, subject, however, to all tenancies or other interests now subsisting in or in respect of the said several parcels of land.
- 253. The proceeds arising from such sale shall be applied in the Board to apply following manner, namely: The proceeds of the sale of the land described in the First Schedule to this Act, and of the buildings and described in First Schedule in erection improvements on the said land, shall be applied in or towards the erection of buildings and improvements for school purposes on the land improvements for
- 30 described in the Second Schedule hereto, or on so much thereof as the land described in Board may decide not to sell.

4. In lieu of erecting such buildings and improvements on the land mentioned in the *Second* Schedule hereto, the Board may, if it thinks fit, acquire another site for the erection of such buildings and improvements, and sell as aforesaid the whole or any part or parts of the lands described in the said *First* and *Second* Schedules, with the buildings and improvements thereon, subject, however, to such tenancies and other interests as aforesaid, and out of the proceeds of such sale pay for the site so to be acquired, and to apply the remainder of such proceeds in or towards the erection of such school-buildings and improvements on such site.

#### FIRST SCHEDULE.

ALL that piece of land situated in the County of Geraldine, Provincial District of Canterbury, New Zealand, being Lots 20 and 21 part of Rural Section 6382, and containing by admeasurement 1 acre 2 roods 18 perches, more or less, commencing at a point on the east side of the Geraldine Road, the said point being 70 links south of a bend in said road; thence north,  $87^{\circ} 40'$  east, a distance of 385 links to the River Waihi, to a point bearing north  $85^{\circ} 28'$  east from the commencing point, and distant therefrom 189 links: as the same is more particularly delineated on plan coloured pink; and Lot 21 is also marked as such in the plan deposited in the Land Registry Office, Christchurch, as No. 19.

Reserve No 346, Town of Geraldine. All that piece of land situate in the Town of Geraldine, Provincial District of Canterbury, New Zealand, being Reserve 346 aforesaid (in red), and containing by admeasurement 1 acre and 39 perches, commencing at the junction of Wilson and Talbot Streets, and having a frontage of 240 links on the latter street and 490 links on the former, being bounded on the southwest and south-east by parallel lines and 250 links and 500 links respectively from said streets; as the same is more particularly delineated on plan, and coloured pink.

#### SECOND SCHEDULE.

RESERVE No. 2625 (in red) in Geraldine Town. Bounded towards the north by Lot No. 19; towards the east by the River Waihi; towards the south by Lot No. 22; and towards the west by the Geraldine Road.

Reserve No. 346. All that piece of land situate in the Town District of Geraldine, Provincial District of Canterbury, containing by admeasurement 1 acre and 39 perches, more or less. Bounded towards the north-west by Wilson Street; towards the north-east by Talbot Street; towards the south-east by Sections Nos. 7A, 8, 9, and 10; and towards the south-west by Section No. 20.

### SECOND SCHEDULE.

**RESERVE** No. 2625 (in red). All that piece of land situate in the Town District of Geraldine, Provincial District of Canterbury, containing by admeasurement 4 acres, more or less. Bounded towards the west by Wilson Street; towards the north by Wright Street; towards the east by Cox Street; and towards the south by South Town-belt.
