A BILL INTITULED

AN ACT to Amend "The Government Railways Act, 1900."

Title.

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. The Short Title of this Act is "The Government Railways Act Amendment Act, 1905," and it shall form part of and be read together with "The Government Railways Act, 1900."

Short Title.

2. (1.) Wherever in the principal Act, or any other Act, authority is given to the Minister to purchase any land or execute any work, such authority shall be deemed to include the payment of interest on any money due in respect of such purchase, or of the execution of such work.

Authority to spend money to cover payment of interest.

(2.) This section shall apply to moneys due in respect of the purchase of any land, or of the execution of any work authorised before, as well as after, the passing of this Act.
