## A BILL INTITULED

AN ACT to Amend "The Government Railways Act, 1900."

BE IT ENACFED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as 5 follows :—

1. The Short Title of this Act is "The Government Railways Short Title. Act Amendment Act, 1905," and it shall form part of and be read together with "The Government Railways Act, 1900."

2. (1.) Wherever in the principal Act, or any other Act, Authority to spend 10 authority is given to the Minister to purchase any land or execute payment of interest. any work, such authority shall be deemed to include the payment of interest on any money due in respect of such purchase, or of the execution of such work.

(2.) This section shall apply to moneys due in respect of the 15 purchase of any land, or of the execution of any work authorised before, as well as after, the passing of this Act.
