## GORE-KELSO RAILWAY CONSTRUCTION AND AUTHORIZATION.

### A BILL INTITULED

AN ACT to authorize the Construction of the Kelso to Gore Railway by or on behalf of Her Majesty the Queen. Title.

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. The Short Title of this Act is "The Gore-Kelso Railway Construction and Authorization Act, 1883." Short Title.

2. The railway mentioned and defined in the Schedule hereto shall be constructed and made by or on behalf of Her Majesty the Queen, in the manner prescribed by "The Public Works Act, 1882;" (hereinafter called "the said Act"), and the cost and charges of such construction shall be paid out of such moneys as now are or hereafter may be appropriated for that purpose by the General Assembly. Railway authorized.

3. This Act is to be deemed a special Act for the purposes of the said Act, and all the provisions of that Act in respect of the construction and making and the management and working of railways by or on behalf of Her Majesty shall be deemed to be incorporated with this Act.
