A BILL INTITULED

AN ACT to vest certain Land in the Mayor, Councillors, and Burgesses of the Borough of Gladstone. Title.

WHEREAS the parcel of land described in the Schedule hereto annexed is now reserved as a site for a lunatic asylum : And whereas it is expedient that the same parcel of land should be vested in the Mayor, Councillors, and Burgesses of the Borough of Gladstone for the purposes hereinafter mentioned : Preamble.

BE IT THEREFORE ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows :—

10 1. The Short Title of this Act is "The Gladstone Recreation Reserve Act, 1882." Short Title.

2. The parcel of land described in the Schedule hereto annexed is hereby vested in the Mayor, Councillors, and Burgesses of the Borough of Gladstone, for the following purposes, that is to say, a portion of the said parcel of land, extending along the whole western side thereof, and extending back easterly from that side a distance of one hundred and twelve links, and another portion thereof extending along the whole northern side thereof, and extending back southerly from that side a distance of fifty links, are hereby vested in the said Mayor, Councillors, and Burgesses of the Borough of Gladstone, as public streets or roads ; and the remainder of the said parcel of land is hereby vested in the said Mayor, Councillors, and Burgesses as a place for the public recreation of the inhabitants of the said borough. Lunatic Asylum reserve vested in Borough of Gladstone for purposes of recreation ground and public roads.

SCHEDULE.

Schedule.

ALL that parcel of land in the Provincial District of Southland, in the Colony of New Zealand, containing by admeasurement ten acres, more or less, being Section twenty-four, Block one, on the Crown grant record map of the Invercargill Hundred. Bounded on the North by Section twenty-five of said block, one thousand and twenty-six links ; on the East by Section twenty-three of said block, nine hundred and seventy-four links ; on the South by Section twenty-two of said block nine hundred and fourteen links, and a public road one hundred and twelve links ; and on the West by Section twenty-nine of said block, nine hundred and seventy-four links.
