A BILL INTITULED

An Act to amend "The Governor's Salary and Allowances Act, Title. 1873."

WHEREAS it is expedient that the sum payable to Her Majesty for Preamble. 5 certain allowances to the Governor should be altered after the expiration of the term of office of the present Governor:

BE IT THEREFORE ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:-

1. The Short Title of this Act is "The Governor's Salary and Short Title. Allowances Act Amendment Act, 1887."

2. From and after the coming into operation of this Act the Repeal of certain third, fourth, and tenth sections of "The Governor's Salary and sections of "The Governor's Salary Allowances Act, 1873," shall be and the same are hereby repealed, and Allowances Act, 1873." Act, 1873." 15 and the "establishment allowance" and "travelling allowance" provided for in the said sections shall cease to be payable, Establishment allowance and and all expenses incurred by the Governor for all or any of the travelling allowance purposes mentioned in the third and fourth sections of the said Act payable. shall be paid and borne by the Governor out of the salary payable 20 to him under the said Act, with the exception of the annual salary of the Clerk of the Executive Council, which shall be paid out of moneys to be appropriated from time to time by the General Assembly.

3. This Act shall not come into operation unless and until the Act to be reserved same shall have been assented to by Her Majesty, and until the for Her Majesty's 25 assumption of the government by the person next appointed by Her

Majesty to be Governor of New Zealand:

No. 69.—1.

Proviso.

Provided that if the assent of Her Majesty shall be signified as aforesaid, and before the date when the same is signified or proclaimed in New Zealand any person shall have been so appointed to be Governor, this Act shall be deemed to have come into operation on the date when such person embarks to assume the government of the colony, whether the port of embarkation be in England or in another colony or elsewhere.
