A BILL INTITULED

AN Act to enable the Greytown Trustees to convey certain Lands Title. for Public Purposes.

- WHEREAS the lands detailed in the Schedules to this Act form Preamble. 5 part of the lands vested in the present Grevtown Trustees pursuant to the provisions of "The Masterton and Greytown Lands Management Acts Amendment Act, 1883 ": And whereas it is expedient that the Greytown Trustees should be empowered to convey or transfer the lands described in the *First* Schedule to this Act to
- 10 the Wairarapa District Hospital Board for the purposes of an infectious diseases hospital, and the land described in the Second Schedule to this Act to the Mayor, Councillors, and Burgesses of the Borough of Greytown for the purposes of a municipal town hall:
- 15 BE IT THEREFORE ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows :---

1. The Short Title of this Act is "The Greytown Trustees Short Title. Empowering Act, 1906."

- 2. The Greytown Trustees for the time being, as defined by Power to convey 20 "The Masterton and Greytown Lands Management Acts Amend- land described in First Schedule. ment Act, 1883," are empowered to convey or transfer to the Wairarapa District Hospital Board the lands described in the First Schedule hereto, to be held by the said Wairarapa District Hospital
- 25 Board upon trust for the purposes of an infectious diseases hospital; and, in the event of the said lands being no longer required for the purposes of an infectious diseases hospital upon trust, to reconvey the same to the Grevtown Trustees; and for that purpose the Wairarapa District Hospital Board is hereby authorised and empowered
- 30 to execute such conveyances or transfers as may be necessary, and such conveyances or transfers shall be valid.

Power to convey land described in Second Schedule. 3. The Greytown Trustees for the time being, as defined by "The Masterton and Greytown Lands Management Acts Amendment Act, 1883," are empowered to convey or transfer to the Mayor, Councillors, and Burgesses of the Borough of Greytown the land described in the *Second* Schedule hereto, to be held by the said 5 Mayor, Councillors, and Burgesses of the Borough of Greytown upon trust for the purposes of a municipal town hall; and, in the event of the said lands being no longer required for the purposes of a municipal town hall upon trust, to reconvey the same to the Greytown Trustees; and for that purpose the said Mayor, Councillors, and 10 Burgesses of the Borough of Greytown are hereby authorised and empowered to execute such conveyances or transfers as may be necessary, and such conveyances or transfers shall be valid.

Evidence of validity of conveyance. 4. A statutory declaration made by any one or more of the Greytown Trustees setting forth that the persons executing any 15 conveyance or transfer under the authority of this Act were the Greytown Trustees at the time of the execution of such conveyance or transfer shall be conclusive evidence for all purposes that such conveyance or transfer has been completely executed by all the Greytown Trustees, and that all the estate and interest of the Grey-20 town Trustees has become vested in the persons or body corporate which may purport to take under such conveyance or transfer.

FIRST SCHEDULE.

ALL that parcel of land situate in the Borough of Greytown, containing 2 acres 1 rood 1 perch, more or less, being the whole of the sections numbered 58, 59, and 60 on the plan of the Town Belt of the Township of Greytown.

SECOND SCHEDULE.

ALL that parcel of land situate in the Borough of Greytown, containing 1 rood 34.7 perches, being the western half part of Section 61 on the plan of the Township of Greytown. Bounded on the north-east by Church Street, 254 links; on the north-west by Main Street, 183.9 links; on the south-west by Section 63 on the said plan, 254 links; and on the south-east by other part of Section 61, 183.9 links.
