A BILL INTITULED

AN ACT to authorize the Survey and Sale or other disposition of a certain Reserve for a Lunatic Asylum in the Borough of Gladstone, in the District of Southland. Title.

5 WHEREAS the land described in the Schedule hereto has been reserved as a site for a lunatic asylum, but is not required for such purpose, and it is expedient that the same should be sold or appropriated for other purposes. Preamble.

10 BE IT THEREFORE ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand, in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. The Short Title of this Act is "The Gladstone Town Improvement Act, 1885." Short Title.

15 2. From and after the passing of this Act the land described in the Schedule hereto shall cease to be a reserve for a lunatic asylum. Land to cease to be a reserve.

3. The land described in the Schedule hereto may, at any time after the passing of this Act, be surveyed and laid off into sections of the area of one rood each or thereabout, and streets, and shall form a portion of the Borough of Gladstone. Land to be surveyed and laid off as part of Borough of Gladstone.

20 4. From the said land the Governor shall set aside a portion, not exceeding one acre in area, which, thereupon, without any conveyance or assurance, shall become vested in the Mayor, Councillors, and Burgesses of the Borough of Gladstone, for municipal purposes. Portion of land to be set aside for municipal purposes.

25 5. The said land may at any time, after setting aside a portion as aforesaid, be sold by the Governor upon such terms as shall be prescribed by Order in Council. Land may be sold by Governor.

SCHEDULE.

ALL that parcel of land, in the Southland Land District, containing by admeasurement 10 acres, more or less, being Section 24, Block I., Invercargill Hundred. Bounded towards the North by original Section 25 of said block 1026 links; towards the East by original Section 23 of said block 974 links; towards the South by Section 22 of said block and by a road-line 1026 links; and towards the West by original Section 29 of said block 974 links. Schedule.
