5 WHEREAS the lands and hereditaments described in the Schedule Preamble. hereunder written having been acquired by the Hawke's Bay and Waipawa United District Charitable Aid Board (hereinafter called "the said Board") for an estate in fee-simple for particular purposes connected with the functions of the said Board, and it having become 10 impossible or inadvisable that the same should be devoted to or used for such purposes, it is expedient that provision should be made whereby such lands and hereditaments may be sold and disposed of by the said Board: And whereas it is also expedient that provision

The purchase-money received by the said Board as the consideration for any such sale or sales as aforesaid shall belong to the Charitable Aid Fund of the said Board, but no purchaser shall be bound to see or inquire as to the application of his purchase-money or be responsible for the misapplication thereof.

Remedies of Board on contracts. 4. On the failure, neglect, or refusal of any purchaser to complete any contract or agreement for purchase it shall be lawful for the said Board to compel specific performance of the same or to recover the unpaid purchase money in any Court of competent jurisdiction.

Power for Board to acquire site for Old Men's Home. 5. It shall be lawful for the said Board to acquire by purchase in fee-simple a suitable site within its district for the purpose of an Old Men's Home or institution for the reception or relief of aged persons, and to erect and maintain thereon any building or institution suitable for such purpose, with all necessary outhouses, enclosures, and accessories as an institution within the meaning of "The Hospital and Charitable Institutions Act, 1885," and the amendments thereof, and to exercise and have all powers, authorities, and discretions conferred by the said Act and amendments with reference to such institution.
