Empowering Act, 1871:"

BE IT THEREFORE ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same,

1. The Short Title of this Act shall be "The Highway Boards Short Title.

Empowering Act 1871 Amendment Act, 1874."

2. All fines and penalties paid or recovered under any of the Fines &c. paid, to provisions of "The Highway Boards Empowering Act, 1871," or any or Road Boards. 10 amendment thereof, or under the provisions of any Road Board or Highway Board Act or Ordinance passed and enacted by the Super-intendent and Provincial Council of any province within which Part IV. of "The Highway Boards Empowering Act, 1871," has been

adopted, or under any by-law made or adopted under the said Part IV. 15 of the said Act, or of any of the said Road Board or Highway Boards Acts or Ordinances passed and enacted as aforesaid, shall be paid over by the Clerk or proper officer of the Court in which the same shall have been recovered to the Road Board or Highway Board of the district within which the offence or breach for which such fines or penalties shall 20 be imposed shall have been committed; and all fines and penalties paid

or recovered under the provisions of the said before-mentioned Acts or the said before mentioned or referred to Acts or Ordinances, or under any of such by-laws as aforesaid, for any act matter or thing done within or with respect to any Road Board or Highway Board District, 25 or for any omission or neglect to do any act matter or thing which ought under the provisions of the said before-mentioned Acts, or the

said before-mentioned Acts or Ordinances, or under any of such bylaws as aforesaid, to have been done within or with respect to any Road Board or Highway Board District, shall be paid to the Road 30 Board or Highway Board of such district; and all such fines and

penalties as aforesaid shall, when received, form part of the Road Board or Highway Board funds or revenue.
