HAWERA CEMETERY.

A BILL INTITULED

AN ACT to close a Portion of a Public Road in the Borough of Hawera, and to declare the same a Public Cemetery. Title.

WHEREAS the piece of land described in the Schedule hereto was originally laid off and still continues to be a portion of a public road in the Borough of Hawera, and is so described and delineated in the plan of the said borough, but has never been used as a public road : And whereas the said piece of land abuts upon and is enclosed as part of the cemetery, set apart as such under "The Cemeteries Act, 1882," and has in time past been used as a cemetery, and interments have been made therein, and tombstones erected thereon, and the same otherwise embellished : And whereas it is desirous that the said piece of land should be closed as a public road, and vested in the trustees for the time being under "The Cemeteries Act, 1882," as a part of the cemetery in the Borough of Hawera aforesaid :

BE IT THEREFORE ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows :—

1. The Short Title of this Act is "The Hawera Cemetery Act, 1886." Short Title.

2. From and after the passing of this Act, the piece of land described in the Schedule hereto shall cease to be a public road, and shall be and be deemed to have been part of the cemetery set apart in the Borough of Hawera under the provisions of "The Cemeteries Act, 1882," and shall vest accordingly in the trustees for the time being of such cemetery. Road to be closed and declared a cemetery.

ALL that piece of land in the Borough of Hawera, containing by admeasurement 2 roods 39 perches, and being that portion of the public road delineated on the plan of the said borough, abutting upon and extending along the northern boundary (743 links) of Block XXXIII. on the plan of the said borough, and being one chain in width.
