A BILL INTITULED

AN ACT to amend "The Impounding Act, 1884."

Title.

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. The Short Title of this Act is "The Impounding Act Amendment Act, 1900." It shall form part of and be read together with "The Impounding Act, 1884" (hereinafter called "the principal Act").

10 2. The second paragraph of section fourteen of the principal Act is hereby amended by inserting next after the word "fenced," in the first line, the words "or unfenced."
