A BILL INTITULED

AN ACT to amend "The Impounding Act, 1884."

Title.

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

5 1. The Short Title of this Act is "The Impounding Act Amendment Act, 1902." It shall form part of and be read together with "The Impounding Act, 1884" (hereinafter called "the principal Act").

Short Title.

10 2. The expression "the nearest pound" occurring in section twelve of the principal Act shall be deemed to mean that pound which, having regard to the condition of roads or rivers, or the like circumstances, can be most conveniently reached.
