A BILL INTITULED

AN ACT to amend the Industrial and Provident Societies Act, 1908. Title.

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the Industrial and Provident Societies Amendment Act, 1923, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Industrial and Provident Societies Act, 1908. Short Title.

10 2. Subparagraph (iv) of paragraph (a) of section eight of the Industrial and Provident Societies Act, 1908, is hereby amended as follows:— Section 8 of Industrial and Provident Societies Act, 1908, amended.

15 (a.) By omitting the words "Once in every year, before the first day of June," and substituting the words "Within three months after the date of the annual balance of the society's accounts"; and

(b.) By omitting the words "thirty-first of December then last inclusively," and substituting the words "date of the annual balance."
