A BILL INTITULED

AN ACT to amend the Iron and Steel Industries Act, 1914.

Title.

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows :—

1. This Act may be cited as the Iron and Steel Industries Amendment Act, 1920, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Iron and Steel Industries Act, 1914 (hereinafter referred to as the principal Act).

Short Title.

2. Section six of the principal Act is hereby amended by omitting the words "nineteen hundred and twenty-four," and substituting the words "nineteen hundred and thirty-one."

Section 6 of principal Act (as to when bounties shall cease) amended.

3. Section nine of the principal Act is hereby amended, as from the date of the passing of that Act, by omitting the words "nineteen hundred and sixteen," and substituting the words "nineteen hundred and twenty-three"; by omitting the words "nineteen hundred and eighteen," and substituting the words "nineteen hundred and twenty-five"; and by omitting the words "nineteen hundred and twenty," and substituting the words "nineteen hundred and twenty-seven."

Section 9 of principal Act (as to notice of intention to claim bounty, and date of commencement of production) amended.

4. Subsection two of section eleven of the principal Act is hereby amended by omitting the words "nineteen hundred and twenty-eight," and substituting the words "nineteen hundred and thirty-five."

Section 11 of principal Act (as to transfer of works to Crown) amended.
