A BILL INTITULED

AN ACT to amend the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Title.
Amendment Act, 1908.

5 BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand
in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as
follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the Industrial Conciliation and Short Title.
Arbitration Amendment Act, 1914, and shall form part of and be
read together with the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration
10 Act, 1908.
2. Section seventy-one of the Industrial Conciliation and Chartered clubs.
Arbitration Amendment Act, 1908, is hereby amended by inserting
the words "or any chartered club" after the words "body corporate."
