WHEREAS the parcel of land described in the First Schedule Preamble. hereto is vested in the Mayor, Councillors, and Burgesses of the Borough of Invercargill, and is held by them in trust as an endowment for the improvement and benefit of the Town of Invercargill: And whereas it is expedient to empower the said Mayor, Councillors, and Burgesses of the Borough of Invercargill to exchange the said parcel of land for the parcel of land described in the Second Schedule

hereto:BE IT THEREFORE ENACTED by the General Assembly of New 15 Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:-

1. The Short Title of this Act is "The Invercargill Corporation Short Title Reserve Exchange Act, 1902."

2. In this Act, if not inconsistent with the context,— "Corporation" means the Mayor, Councillors, and Burgesses of the Borough of Invercargill, constituted under "The Municipal Corporations Act, 1900":

"Council" means the Council of the said borough.

3.
