### A BILL INTITULED

AN ACT to amend "The Inebriates Institutions Act, 1898." Title.

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. The Short Title of this Act is "The Inebriates Institutions Amendment Act, 1902"; and it shall form part of and be read together with "The Inebriates Institutions Act, 1898." Short Title.

2. Where any person detained in an institution is convicted a second time under section sixteen of "The Inebriates Institutions Act, 1898," the Magistrate may commit him to prison for any period not exceeding twelve months. Punishment of unruly inmates.
