## A BILL INTITULED

An Act to postpone the Election of a Licensing Com- Title. mittee for the Invercargill Licensing District.

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New 5 Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:-

1. This Act may be cited as the Invercargill Short Title. Licensing Committee Act, 1944.

2. (1) The day to be appointed by the Governor- Date to be 10 General under section ten of the Licensing Amendment appointed by Act, 1910, for the first election of the elective members General of a Licensing Committee for the Invercargill Licensing for election of Invercargill District shall be such day as the Governor-General in Licensing his discretion thinks fit, being not later than the twelfth Committee. 15 day of September, nineteen hundred and forty-four.

(2) Until the day to be appointed as aforesaid for Vol. IV, the said election the Invercargill Licensing District p. 351 shall be deemed for all purposes to be a no-license district within the meaning of the Licensing Act, 1908,
