A BILL INTITULED

AN ACT to prohibit the Importation of Intoxicating Liquors into
the Colony of New Zealand. Title.

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Par-
5 liament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. The Short Title of this Act is "The Importation of Intoxi- Short Title.
cating Liquors Prohibition Act, 1891."

2. On and after the passing of this Act it shall not be lawful to Prohibition.
import into the Colony of New Zealand any intoxicating liquor of
10 any kind whatsoever, except for medicinal purposes.

Any intoxicating liquor imported in contravention of this Act
shall be forfeited, and any person directly or indirectly concerned in
such breach shall forfeit and pay a penalty of not less than *one*
hundred pounds nor more than *five hundred* pounds, recoverable, with
15 full costs of suit, by any person informing in respect thereof.
