- 5 BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows : ---

1. The Short Title of this Act is "The Importation and Short Title. Manufacture of Intoxicating Liquors Prohibition Act, 1894."

10 2. On and after the passing of this Act it shall not be lawful to Prohibition. import into, or manufacture in, the Colony of New Zealand, any intoxicating liquors of any kind whatsoever.

3. Any intoxicating liquors imported or manufactured in contra- Forfeiture and penalty. vention of this Act shall be forfeited, and any person directly or

15 indirectly concerned in such breach shall forfeit and pay a penalty of not less than one hundred pounds nor more than five hundred pounds, recoverable, with full costs of suit, by any person informing in respect thereof; in default of the fine and costs being paid, to be imprisoned for not less than three months nor more than twelve months.
