A BILL INTITULED

AN ACT to amend "The Indictable Offences Summary Jurisdiction Title.  
Amendment Act, 1900."

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand  
5 in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as  
follows:—

1. The Short Title of this Act is "The Indictable Offences Short Title.  
Summary Jurisdiction Act Amendment Act, 1903."

2. Section six of "The Indictable Offences Summary Jurisdic- Repeal.  
10 tion Amendment Act, 1900" (conferring the right to claim trial by  
jury in summary cases), and section fifteen of the same Act (limiting  
to Stipendiary Magistrates the power to commit for sentence) are  
hereby repealed.

3. The jurisdiction conferred upon the Supreme Court by  
15 section fourteen of "The Indictable Offences Summary Jurisdiction  
Amendment Act, 1900," may be exercised by the District Court or a  
Judge thereof in respect of all offences within the jurisdiction of the  
District Court, and sections thirteen and fourteen of that Act shall,  
*mutatis mutandis*, apply to such Court. Committal to  
District Court for  
sentence.
