In addition to all sums otherwise granted, there may be £150,000 and £5,500 10 issued and applied, by way of imprest, towards making good the advanced on imprest towards supply granted to Her Majesty for the service of the year ending service of year the thirty-first day of March, one thousand eight hundred and ending 31st March, pinety six

(1.) Out of the respective funds and accounts (being part of the 15 Public Account) specified in the First Schedule hereto, any sums of money not exceeding in the whole one hundred and fifty thousand pounds, as set forth in that Schedule; and also

(2.) Out of the respective accounts mentioned in the Second Schedule hereto, the respective sums therein set forth, amounting in the whole to five thousand five hundred

pounds.

3. The aforesaid sums shall be charged in the manner hereafter charged as expressed in Acts to be passed to be expressed in any Act or Acts passed in this present session of by Parliament. 25 Parliament for appropriating the public revenues of the colony for the year ending the thirty-first day of March, one thousand eight hundred and ninety-six.
